DOG LICENCE

**DOING OUR PART IN OUR
COMMUNITIES**

No person shall keep a dog unless he or she is above the age of 18 years, and holds a licence granted by the Comptroller of the Inland Revenue Department.



ARE YOU A DOG OWNER?

Well, April marks the beginning of the Dog Licence Period. Every owner is required to licence their dog/dogs four months and over.

LICENSING OF DOGS

An application for a dog licence shall be made to the Comptroller, Inland Revenue Department in the prescribed manner.

INFORMATION NEEDED FOR LICENSING

The cashier at the Inland Revenue Department should be provided with the name and address of the owner, the colour and sex of the dog, and the number of dogs kept at premises.

COST OF THE LICENCE

The licence fee is **EC\$25.00** per year. Upon payment you will receive a receipt and a metal badge.

METAL BADGE (DOG TAG)

The metal badge should be attached to the dog's collar for the duration of the licensed period.

In the event of a lost metal badge, the owner shall report to the Comptroller within 1 week of the loss, and on satisfactory proof, shall issue another badge at the prescribed fee.

DURATION OF LICENCE

Every licence commences on the day it is granted (the payment date) and shall expire on the 31st day of March following.

A dog licence is personal to whom the licence is issued and is not transferable.

PENALTY FOR KEEPING DOGS WITHOUT A LICENCE

A person that fails to licence a dog, may result in prosecution and/or court fines.

Remember now, police officers are authorized to make checks on premises for any unlicensed
