Make your vehicle stand out with a custom vanity plate! Here is the outline of all the details you need to create a plate that's uniquely yours.



# **HOW TO APPLY**

Express yourself with letter and numbers in almost any combination!

- Private/Commercial Vehicles: Choose 3 to 7 characters (no symbols).
- Motorcycles: Choose 3 to 5 characters (no symbols)

# YOUR PERSONALIZED IDENTIFICATION MARKS

Applying for a vanity plate is simple! Just

follow these steps:

- Forms available at Inland Revenue Department.
- Cost
- 1. New plates: EC \$350
- 2. Replacement Plates (if lost or damaged):EC \$500

# DESIGN & CUSTOMIZATION GUIDELINES

#### **Inscriptions & Design:**

- The word "ANGUILLA" will appear at the top of your plate, centered above your personalized identification marks.
- Font: Pristina, a sleek and stylish look.
  - Motorcycles: Font size between 32and 40 points.
  - o Cars: Font size no smaller than 54 points.

#### **Size & Material:**

- Cars: 6 inches high by 12 inches wide.
- **Motorcycles**: 4 inches high by 7 inches wide.
- Plates are made from 28-gauge reflective aluminum, ensuring durability with a minimum thickness of 0.027 inches.

# RESTRICTIONS TO KEEP IN MIND

To maintain clarity and prevent confusion, there are a few important rules:

- Readability: Combinations that are hard to read or contain more than four identical characters in a row will be rejected.
- No Interchangeable Characters:

  Avoid using similar-looking

  substitutions (e.g., S for 5, A for 4,

  etc.).
- Licensed Business Names: You can't use a pattern that mimics a registered business name unless you own it.
- Comptroller's Discretion: The

  Comptroller has the authority to reject

  any design or combination that

  doesn't meet the criteria.
